



Nelson Camera Club End of Year Project Challenge

"2020 The year That Was"

Prepare a set of six images

Your images should show a diverse range of photography skills- e.g. monochrome, portrait, macro, food, flowers, insects, animals, landscapes, street photography, sport etc, etc

The photographer chooses or creates a title that fits their set of 6 photos

Examples: Lockdown changed my life....., A year of two halves....., Bubbles and beyond, Oh what a year, 2020 - I'll remember it because..., Living In Interesting Times, In your Bubble, Creativity in Restricted Times, etc etc

- The set of 6 can be Print or Digital but not a combination of the two
 - All Images for your set must have been taken in 2020
- A Projected Image set should flow from one image to the next as they are projected
- For the print set it is important to consider the "balance and flow" of the entire set

These are guidelines and the exercise is about having some fun with your photography
