Common Duck Dive

This image is beautifully matted showing off your duck feeding. Your subject is well placed in the frame. However with a nature image of a bird or animal I need to see its eye. Next time photograph a duck showing its head and particularly seeing at least one eye. This gives much more interest to your subject. NA

Female Tomtit

A small bird like this one is not easy to photograph. You have done well with a non-distracting background. Its eye and beak is well focused and seeing detail of its feathers is excellent. It is well placed in the frame. Well done with a difficult subject. Hon Deb Corbett

Octopus Stinkhorn

This is a striking bright fungus to photograph, well seen. I like seeing the detail of its fingers [also known as 'Devils Fingers] showing the smelly goo which attracts the flies who disperse the spores.
