Congratulations and thank you for volunteering to do a 'My Photography' presentation at Camera Club.

We've changed the format a little for 2020 to match the popular Pecha Kucha (Japanese translation: *chit-chat*) movement that's been growing around the world since 2003. Pecha Kucha's 20x20 presentation format has a very strict structure: 20 images, each shown for 20 seconds. In other words, you've got 400 seconds to tell your story, with your images guiding the way.

To help you (if you wish to use it), there's a PowerPoint template available from the Resource area of the website that you can download and drop your images into. Each page/image is timed to fade to the next image after exactly 20 seconds so you don't need to worry about setting that up. You can however change the look of the slides in the presentation to suit your needs.

When you've finished creating your presentation, save it as a .ppsx file which will then play as a slideshow.

Of course, you may choose to use a different programme to create your presentation with, and that's absolutely fine. If you do however, please be sure to stick to the 20x20 format.

So – choose the images you'll share, write a few notes, practice a bit and then you're ready to share it with everyone 😊
