


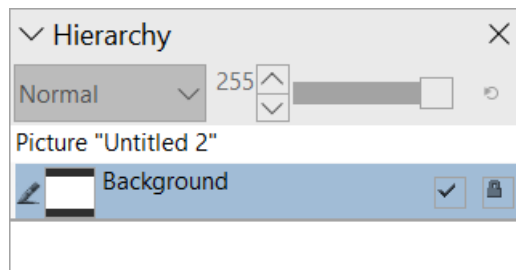
Working with Stylepix to create Pep Ventosa image

1. Open the programme

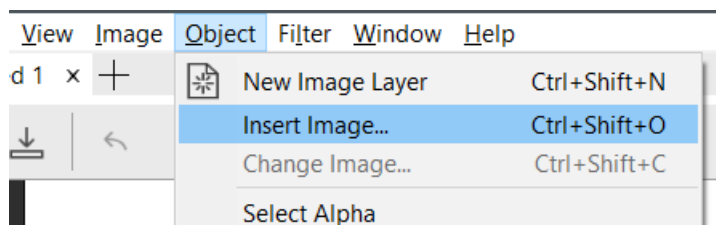
2. Click Ctrl-N or click  near top left

3. Make the dimensions roughly the size your images are and click OK

4. A 'Background' image opens up under the Hierarchy tab on the right hand side:



5. Now click Ctrl-Alt-O to insert an image or click Object > Insert Image



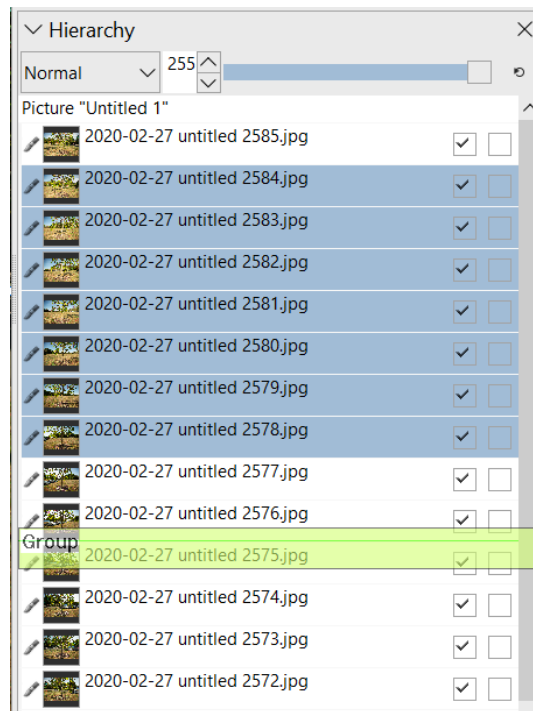
6. This will open up an explorer window. Navigate to wherever your images are stored on your computer, then...

7. Select the images you want to use

- **Ctrl-A will select all images in the folder or
- **hold Ctrl down and click individually on the images you want to use or
- **click on the first image then Ctrl+Shift and click on the last image to select a contiguous set

8. Click Open and hey presto – images are now layers in one document.

9. You can change the order of the layers by selecting the layers you want to move (see ** above) then dragging them to where you want them to be and dropping them.



10. Once your images are in the order you want, adjust the 'Opacity' for each layer. Starting at the top with the lowest percentage (eg 5%) then gradually moving down the layers and increasing the opacity level. NB StylePix uses a 255 point scale to 'measure' its Opacity so roughly 12-13 points equals 5%. Remember, it doesn't have to be accurate though and there are no rules.
